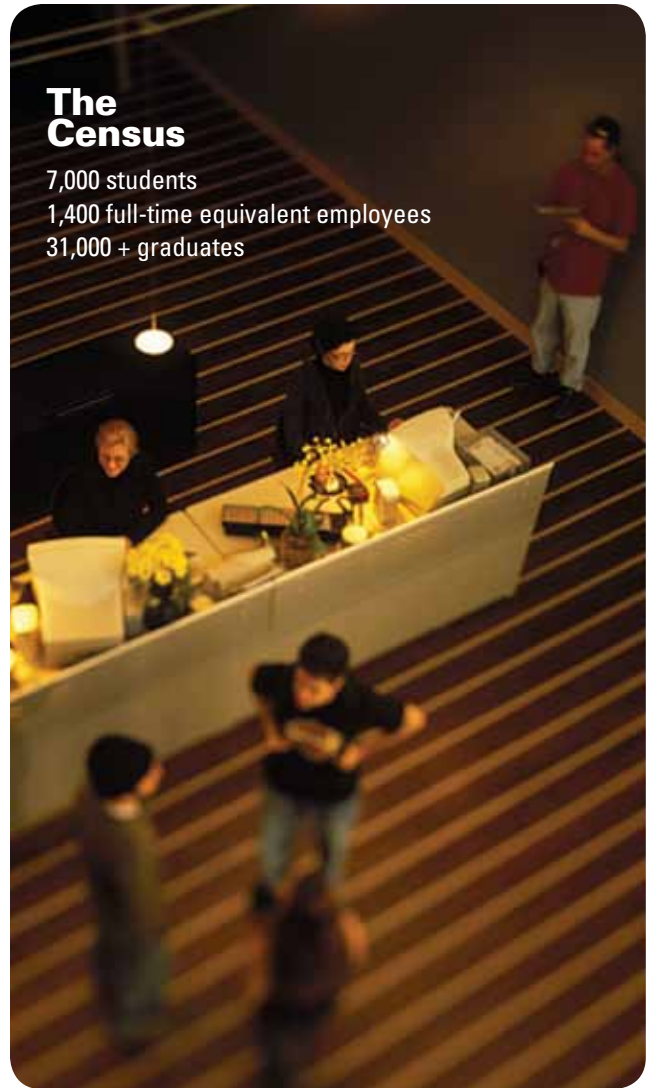

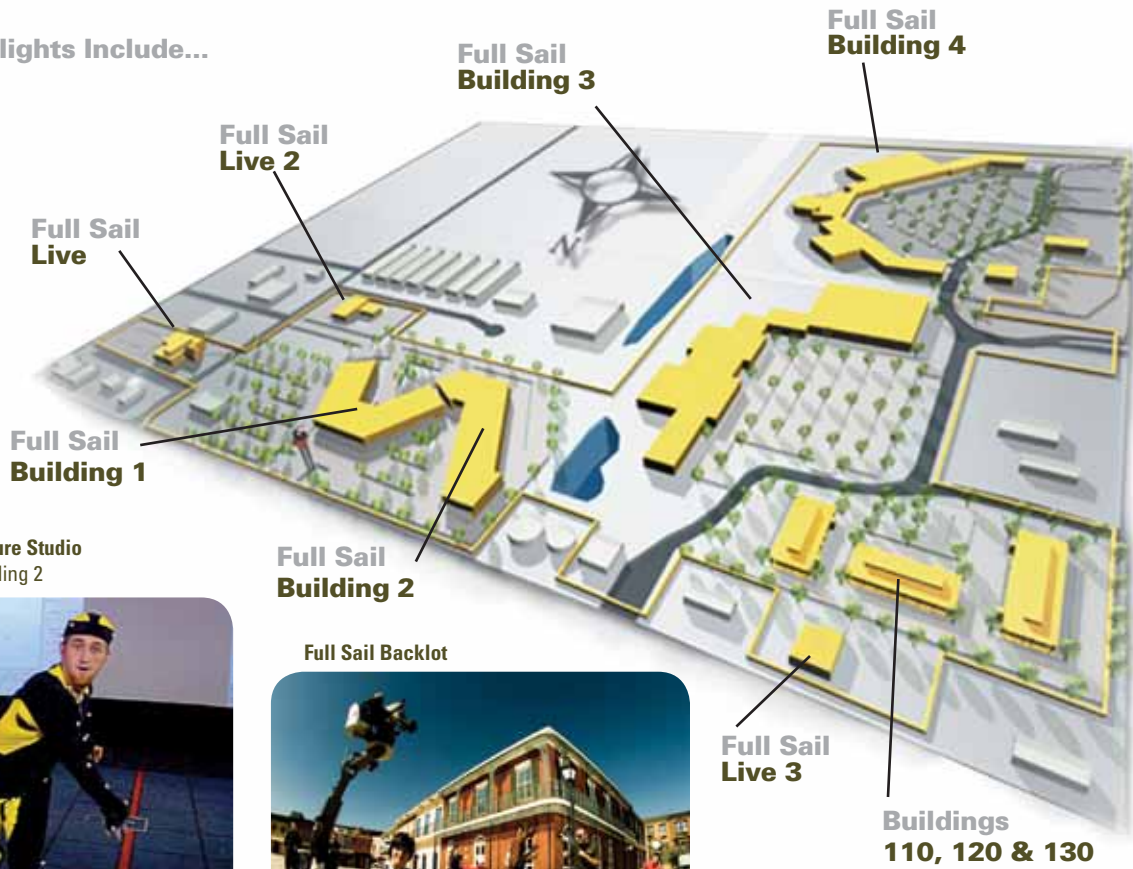
Full Sail's Economic Impact

2009 GRAMMY Awards

106 graduates worked on 78 GRAMMY® nominated projects and over the years 19 Full Sail Graduates have won a total of 28 GRAMMY Awards.

Full Sail Graduates have recorded, mixed, or assisted on every GRAMMY Winning Album of the Year for 15 of the last 17 years (since 1991).

Hollywood Highlights

In 2006, Film graduate, Darren Lynn Bousman, served as Director on the #1 Halloween weekend box office film, *Saw III*. This marks the 2nd installment of the series Darren has Directed in addition to co-writing *Saw II*. Darren returned to the Director's Chair for the 2007 release of *SAW IV*.

2009 Oscars

34 Full Sail graduates were involved in the production of 15 Oscar-nominated films this year. Recording Arts graduate, Gary Rizzo, was personally nominated in the category of Best Achievement in Sound Mixing for the film, *The Dark Knight*. Graduates were also credited in the categories of Best Picture, Best Animated Feature, Visual Effects and more, on motion pictures including: *Wall-E*, *Iron Man*, *The Wrestler* and *Frost/Nixon*.
